Members to receive an update on the review of the mem and arts as presented to Diocesan Synod in November 2022.

"This Synod supports the Directors of the WDBF in their intention to amend the Mem & Arts of the WDBF to:

- Remove the automatic requirement for the Bishop of Winchester to be the Chair of the WDBF
- ii. Allow for a wider membership of the WDBF, having all the members of Winchester Diocesan Synod as company law members of the Charity (provided they consent to do so)."

"This Synod recognises that these changes to be subject to:

- Consultation and approval from Diocesan Synod to accept this additional responsibility.
- ii. Consultation and confirmation from the CharityCommission of the proposed changes to the Mem & Arts
- iii. The Directors of the WDBF reviewing and approving the final revised wording once the Charity Commission and solicitors have finalised the amendment."

"This Synod approves a change to the Standing Orders of the Winchester Diocesan Synod to increase the elected membership of the House of Laity by 4, to ensure there is a small majority of lay members on the Synod. This change to come into effect at the next Diocesan Synod elections in 2024."
