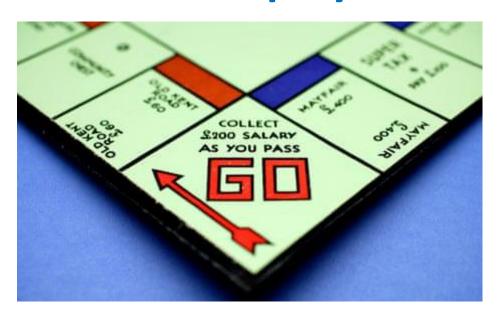
Monopoly
