4 CARE FOR YOUR WASTE – PLASTIC, FOIL & CARDBOARD



REFLECTION

An area that we can have significant impact on is our waste. Particularly how much we have and what we do with it. The key words here are reduce, reuse, then recycle. Cutting down our waste can have a much bigger impact on both our carbon emissions and our local environment than we realise.

CARING FOR CREATION AS AN INDIVIDUAL



Think about your waste and consider what changes you might be able to make. Double check your local authority website to see what you can and can't recycle – you might be surprised! Why not commit to five permanent plastic free swaps over the next month? Or reduce your rubbish by buying loose vegetables and fruit or using a refill/plastic free shop.

CARING FOR CREATION AS A CHURCH



Consider working together as a community and becoming a recycling hub for hard to recycle objects like crisp packets, plastic bags or ready meal containers. Organise a local litter pick, or get involved in one already taking place in your area.
