EXTRAS: The fees shown in the table do <u>not</u> include charges for heating, the services of a verger, music (e.g. organist, choir), bells, and flowers, which are fixed by the Parochial Church Council. In the case of a marriage service or a funeral service in church, any costs and expenses incurred in respect of routine administration (including arranging dates and times and the making of entries in registers), making the church available and lighting it are included in the fee prescribed as payable to the Parochial Church Council.

The 2020 Parochial Fees Table changed the apportionment of the fee for a funeral service at a cemetery or crematorium so that the PCC no longer received any part of the fee. In response, the WDBF issued the following 'direction':

- The WDBF will permit every PCC that processes a fee for a funeral service taking place in premises belonging to funeral director to retain £30 of that fee before forwarding the remainder to the WDBF. This will effectively leave the PCC in the same position as it was prior to the fees change in 2020.'

Glossary:

PTO - Permission to Officiate, a licence given to clergy by the diocesan bishop after DBS checks and safeguarding training. PTO clergy are often retired but not always. * Non PTO Clergy - including rectors, vicars, team rectors, team vicars, priests-in-charge, associate/assistant priest/minister/vicar/rector, curate, assistant curate. * PTO Clergy - those who have applied to and been granted Permission to Officiate by the diocesan bishop, a 3 year licence which must be renewed.
