

ARCHDEACON'S PARISH VISITATION INFORMATION

Archdeacons' Parish Visitations should take place approximately every 5 years. These may be done by the Archdeacon, Area Dean's, Assistant Area Dean's and trained Lay representatives.

The visitation has two purposes:

- a. To ensure that everything is in good order and that the legal requirements pertaining to parish life are being properly met.

To check that the parish is complying with the requirements of various Measures; in particular, the Inspection of Churches Measures 2019, the Parochial Registers and Records Measure 1978 and the Care of Churches and Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction Measure 2018.

- c. To give an opportunity for you to reflect on the life, mission and ministry of your parish and to share something of that with your Archdeacon or Area Dean etc.
