

Something to listen to:



We can see 'theologically' as well as read and listen. Each week I will include some artwork for you to view, in addition to any artwork used in the tutorial videos.




'Christ shows himself to Thomas' by Rowan and Irene LeCompte, Washington National Cathedral.




Something to listen to:
